Some positions include:

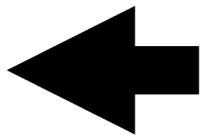
Course Marshals - No experience necessary, marshaling is a great place to start! Some marshals monitor intersections on the stages to ensure no unauthorized cars or people enter the stage, while others monitor spectator areas to ensure all spectating is done as safely as possible.

Control Workers- Arrival and finish control workers work the start and stop of each stage and record times. Main time control workers monitor cars in service areas.

Radio Operators- Efficient communication is key to the success of the rally. Licensed HAM radio operators are needed to provide the safety net for the rally.

Medical Operators - Medical teams are located at various locations on the special stages to assure minimal response times should any medical assistance be needed.
