

SAFETY QUICK GUIDE



*Rally Stages are extremely dangerous.
By being on stage, you are taking the responsibility for your life into your own hands.
Competition cars will be extremely fast and unpredictable.*

On Stage Conduct:

- No Substance Abuse
- Beware wild animals, ticks, poison ivy - we have all
- Pack in - Pack out: Scout rules on trash
- Respect the marshalls
- Be predictable
- Be considerate of other spectators

On Stage MANDATORY SAFETY RULES:

- No standing on OUTSIDE OF CORNERS
- No standing in IMPACT ZONES (runoffs, tight corners, after jumps, etc.)
- **Do not stand ON RACING SURFACE** at any time
- STAY ON YOUR FEET - do not sit, kneel or lay down
- 0 car has the ability to cancel a stage for safety concerns - don't be that guy that gets a stage thrown
- No walking down a hot stage to exit
- Movement needs to happen far away from road if leaving early

CAUTION CAUTION CAUTION

YELLOW MAY BE OK = Follow the direction of your guide to see if it is ok to stand here

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RED IS DANGEROUS = **never stand behind red tape**
Red tape areas are identified as extremely high risk
